Storrs Pond Ready to Kickoff Eventful Summer Attractive Membership Plan Offered for 2007

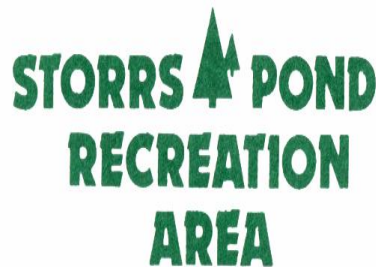
SPLASH BASH '07

Events will include live music, games, a scavenger hunt, hiking and a special presentation by the Vermont Institute of Natural Science.

The Improvement Society and the community have always viewed the recreation area as a precious asset to the entire Upper Valley community. The Improvement Society wishes

To achieve that goal we have reduced the Season Membership Fee to \$50. By signing up as a Storrs Pond "member" you will be donating to the operation of Storrs Pond as well as supporting and preserving Storrs Pond for future generations to enjoy. Whether or not your family plans to use the facility, your "membership" will help to preserve Hanover's natural treasure. A "membership" allows you access to the area

where you can swim in the guarded pond and enjoy a picnic or family outing.

Swimming Program

Individuals who wish to use the pool may do so by either purchasing a pass for the day or receive a discount by purchasing a seasons' pool pass. The swimming pool will be open from 5:30 a.m. to 7:45 p.m. Swimming Instruction is available for all levels, using the standard American Red Cross curriculum and certified Water Safety Instructors. Complete lesson information available in the Storrs Pond business office. Brian King will be running the swimming program for Storrs Pond this summer. Brian is the Director and Head Coach of the North Country Aquatics Club. Missie Rodriguez will be returning for her 13th year as head of the Water Safety Instructors. A season swimming pass for a family of

four will cost \$175, with a charge of \$25 for additional family members. There also will be individual passes for sale. An alternative is to pay for a daily pass priced at \$5 for adults and \$3 for children less than 15 years of age. Come enjoy the only heated, outdoor pool in the Upper Valley!

The 2007 Season & Programs

The Storrs Pond Area officially opens for the season on May 21st. The swimming pool will be open but will have reduced hours. The season officially opens with a full operating schedule on Saturday, June 23. The Area will be open to the public daily from 5:30 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. The pool will remain open through Labor Day weekend. Storrs Pond will host several events for the community throughout the summer. A full schedule will be available on our website by June 1 or by stopping in the Storrs Pond business office and picking up a program guide. A longer

pool day and pool season aren't the only changes you'll notice at Storrs Pond this year. We have renovated the pool house creating more light and space and made the outside of the building more attractive. We have moved the fence around the pool deck several yards toward the tennis courts to create more room and shaded areas. We have also made Storrs S'Mores accessible from the pool so customers won't have to walk through the pool house to get their treats. You'll also notice our lifeguards not sitting in the usual chairs as they work. Instead they will be walking alongside the edge of the pool as they do their job. The pool will always have a lap lane available for swimmers. In addition to our group and private swim lessons we will offer Adult Fitness Classes, Masters Triathlon and Swimming Teams, Pool Lane rental, Canoe rental and we will have another summer of fun and exercise with our "Fiddlehead 5" running races. We plan on having three big community events this summer that will feature movies, food, activities, games and races. We hope you can come down and check out the *new* Storrs Pond. Storrs Pond requires that an adult accompany children under the age of 12.
